Terms of Reference for State Advisory Group on Community Action (SAGCA) or State Mentoring Group (SMG)

- 1) Advise on developing and strengthening partnerships for community action under the National Health Mission (NHM)
- Endorse critical processes such as guidelines and criteria for selections of NGOs/ CBOs, manuals and tools etc.
- 3) Facilitate necessary directives/guidelines to support programme implementation.
- 4) Periodically review progress on the implementation of the programme.
- 5) Facilitate greater inter-departmental coordination and convergence.
- 6) Recommend mechanisms for timely financial disbursement of fund under the programmme.

Terms of Reference for State - Technical Advisory Group (STAG)

- a) To suggest strategies for CAH intervention at different levels.
- b) To provide technical inputs for developing training modules for different stakholders, IEC/BCC materials, report card, facility card etc.

- c) Regular field visits to monitor the progress and feedback sharing with the State Health Society.
- d) Regular meeting to review the progress of programme implementation at different levels and provide suggestions for gearing up the programme .
- e) To suggest new interventions in upcoming years PIP for improving the implementation of CAH programme.

These groups will hold meetings at least once in a quarter and review the implementation and progress of CAH (Community Action on Health) component. Any other officer(s) may also be associated in the meetings if required so.
