Background

The state received a briefing on Community Action for Health during the workshop for State Nodal Officers on Community Action for Health in October 2013. The state proposed to initiate the process in two blocks of a High Priority District. The activity got approved in the FY 2013-14 for Dhalai district on a pilot basis.

- The state and district ASHA Resource Centre were designated as state nodal agency and district nodal agency
- The state has disseminated the draft EOI to district for selection of block NGOs, which was not rolled out
- The budget approved under CBPM activities was not utilized in the FY 2013-14. The same activity was proposed for the FY 2014-15.

Current Activities

- The community monitoring component got approved in the ROP 2014-15 with a budget of Rs 4.85 lakhs for one district 'Gomati' as a new activity on pilot basis
- The state nodal officer was oriented during the VHSNC training for North East on June 3-5, 2015.

Proposed Activities for 2015-16

- Organise state /district level orientation workshop
- Organise a district level TOT in Gomati district on perspective building
